Knowledge of an additional language improves critical thinking skills and broadens one's appreciation of the world and its people. A French minor is invaluable to anyone heading into a graduate school program with a second-language requirement or seeking work in the federal public service.

The French Minor is 18 senior-level credits with a minimum of six FREN credits at the 300-level.
