

FOUNDATION PROGRAM - INTERNATIONAL

Admission Requirements

All applicants must meet an acceptable level of English language proficiency. This program requires proof of successful completion of standardized language evaluation such as an overall IELTS score of 5.5 with no skill under 4.5, or equivalent.

Once admitted to the program students may be required to write a placement test to determine their current academic standing and placement level in the program.

MacEwan International Support

- Set up a Canadian bank account.
- Get your MacEwan University photo ID card.
- Once registered you can pick up your U-Pass (bus and train) with SAMU.

Application Process

Online applications are processed through ApplyAlberta (<https://www.applyalberta.ca>), an application service used by most post-secondary institutions in Alberta. You will need to pay a non-refundable application fee (<https://www.macewan.ca/wcm/Registrar/FeesandFinancialInformation/TuitionFees/OtherFees/>) to complete your online application as well as update your transcripts and documents from outside of Canada.
