CYCS - CYBERSECURITY COMPUTER SCIENCE

CYCS 200

Information Security, An Overview 3 Credits Weekly (3-0-0)

In this course, students will explore the fundamentals of information security. They will learn how to protect personal and professional data while gaining a deeper understanding of cyber threats and best practices for online safety.

Prerequisites: A minimum grade of C- in CMPT 101.

CYCS 300

Introduction To Cyber Risk Management

3 Credits Weekly (3-0-0)

Students will learn to value cyber and network assets in terms of Confidentiality, Availability, and Integrity (CIA) and gauge the likelihood of a cyber attack that removes or diminishes one or more of CIA. Students will practice combining these types of analysis to recommend cyber risk management courses of action, including business continuity. *Prerequisites: A minimum grade of C- in CYCS 200 or CMPT 280.*
