OOSC 200 School Age Care and Development

Students examine the role of the child care professional and the goals and philosophy of school age care programs for children ages 6 to 12. Students learn about the school age child, their developmental characteristics, interests and capabilities. Students apply this knowledge to developing play experiences for the school-age child in a group care setting. Students discover and explore recreational and educational resources in the community. An overview of current legislation, standards and professional qualifications that support quality school age programs
