

# TUITION

Students are required to make a direct financial contribution to the operating costs that come with educational activities. Tuition is a charge that supports the cost of instruction and is calculated by taking the number of course credits multiplied by the per-credit tuition rate for the program.

Tuition is established and reviewed on an annual basis through the university's approval process in accordance with the provincial *Tuition and Fees Regulations* made under the *Post-Secondary Learning Act*.

## Domestic Tuition

Domestic tuition applies to Canadian citizens, Permanent Residents and Convention Refugees.

## Credit Courses

International students enrolled in Open Studies, degree, diploma or certificate programs will be assessed a minimum tuition rate equivalent to nine credits in the Fall and Winter terms, and on a per-credit basis during the Spring/Summer term. International students enrolled in preparatory programs will be assessed a minimum tuition rate equivalent to a full-credit load in all terms.
