The Professional Communication minor in MacEwan University's Bachelor of Communication Studies program offers students a focused pathway to enhance their communication skills. The 18-credit minor comprises two core courses in Grammar and Composition Foundations and Communication Theory plus 12 credits of specialized options. Students must complete BCSC 307 and can choose from a diverse range of courses covering areas such as editing, technical communication, rhetoric, and organizational communication. This minor equips students with practical writing, editing, and strategic communication planning skills, preparing them for various professional contexts. The program's flexibility allows students to tailor their learning to specific interests within the broad field of professional communication, offering a variety of exciting learning.
