Additional Courses

- Student can take a combination of English as an Additional Language, University Preparation and Open Studies

Admission Requirements

All applicants must meet an acceptable level of English language proficiency. This program requires proof of successful completion of a standardized language evaluation, such as an overall IELTS score of 5.5 with no skill under 4.5, or equivalent.

Once admitted to the program, students may be required to write a placement test to determine their current academic standing and placement level.
